## From Brides Parents

Brides Parents Name  
request the honour of the company of  
Guest Name  
at the marriage of their daughter

Brides Name  
with  
Grooms Name

at (ceremony)  
(ceremony address)  
on (date and time)  
and afterwards at(reception venue)  
(reception venue address)

## From Bride and Groom

Brides Name  
and  
Grooms Name  
request the pleasure of the company of  
Guest Name  
to share in the celebration of our marriage  
at (ceremony)  
(ceremony address)  
on (date)  
at (time)

and afterwards at  
(reception)  
(reception address)  
at (time)

## From Bride and Groom's Parents

(brides parents)  
together with  
(grooms parents)  
request the pleasure of your company  
Guest Name  
at the marriage of their daughter

Brides Name  
with  
Grooms Name

at (ceremony)  
(ceremony address)  
on (date and time)  
and afterwards at(reception venue)  
(reception venue address)

## From Bride and Groom with Parents

Together with their parents  
(brides name)  
and  
(grooms name)  
request the pleasure of the company of  
(guest)

at their marriage  
at (ceremony)  
(ceremony address)  
on (date)  
at (time)

and afterwards at  
(reception)  
(reception address)  
at (time)

To omit the name of the guest and avoid having to hand write each guest name, simply change the wording of the invitation to read something like this:  
"request the pleasure of your company" or "would be delighted if you would join them in celebrating".
